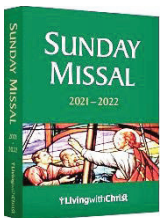

THE SEASON OF ADVENT


Advent (November 28) marks the beginning of the liturgical year. While it expresses the deep longing of all humanity for God, it celebrates the three-fold coming of the Lord: remembering the events that surrounded the Lord's coming long ago, celebrating his coming among us today, and looking forward to his final coming in glory. Advent is a season of devout and joyful expectation. Its four Sundays (with its actual length determined by the weekday of Christmas) highlight our desire and longing for peace, justice and unity. The first part of Advent looks forward to the parousia, the Lord's glorious return at the end of time and reflects on his presence among us today. The second part is a direct preparation for Christmas the yearly commemoration of Jesus' coming among us in human flesh. Although the length of Advent once extended back to November 11th and was generally celebrated as a season of penance (St. Martin's Lent), its character today is expressed in terms of anticipation, longing and incompleteness. We journey through Advent toward the consummation of human history and prepare for the Christmas feast. Advent is a period of quiet and moderation;
