Year End Report to the Parishioners of St. Clement's Church

In 2022, the 17 members of the St. Clement's Church Society of St. Vincent de Paul provided grocery vouchers and other assistance totaling more than \$39,000 to the needy in Cambridge within the boundaries of St. Clement's Church. Funds donated to our Society were used to support 387 needy families (including 663 adults and their 441 children) during 2022.

This past Christmas, 13 St. Vincent de Paul members delivered Christmas greetings containing gift cards and grocery vouchers worth about \$13,900 to 71 needy families (including 125 adults and their 107 children). Our main source of funds comes from the generosity of the parishioners of St. Clement's Church. We thank you very, very much for your continued support of our Society as we strive to fulfill our mandate – the Christian calling to seek and find the suffering, the forgotten, and the deprived, and to bring them God's love through the gift of food and compassion.


