From the Pastor's Desk

Finances, Finances, Finances! It's been on my mind, and not because there's been an issue, in fact I am so thankful for your support, helping us to keep the lights and heat on, the needy in our community fed and warm, not to mention the opportunities that keep opening up to bring Christ to ever greater life in programs and through use of our space. I want to update you about a few things finance related, sadly only so much detail is possible here, but I wanted to at least let you know what's being worked on.

First, just a small note, as elsewhere in this bulletin says, the 2022 tax receipts were mailed out this week. I was able to personally sign a number of them, and to add a small note of thanks, THANK YOU ALL! If you gave through Canada Helps you can find your 2022 receipt by signing in @ canadahelps.ca. One Heart One Soul (OHOS) contributions are receipted directly by the diocese, watch your snail mail!

Ok, second, our Finance Council. I want to thank all those who have helped on this for years past, many of them serving well beyond their term of office (normally a 3 year term, renewable once), they all served so generously! As the new pastor of SC, it is my responsibility to establish a finance council, within 3 months of taking over. I asked the diocese for an extension to this; they allowed me to early in the NY, and so the time has come! Having met with former members of the council and getting to know others in the parish I have asked 3 persons to step into this role, hoping to expand to 4 or 5 in the years to come. We are aiming to have our first meeting as a council in the coming weeks, reviewing the current state of things, and looking towards a proper finance report for you for the year ending 2022 sometime in the spring. I should note the diocesan 2022 report just went in, thank you Dee for all your work on this!

Finally, our OHOS Campaign. This was a great success back in 2020, and though the transitions in leadership here at SC have slowed things down I am absolutely committed to seeing through our *Gathering Space* project, and utilizing the funds donated to this end. In fact, since the summer months I have been meeting with Architects and Construction firms, and doing some preliminary work to kick start the project and building phase of the campaign. We have engaged Lintack Architects to finalize the detailed plans for the Gathering Space project, and to develop a broad strokes 'Strategic Plan' to address other areas of need we hope to tackle in the years ahead. We want to make sure when we get to work, and we will soon, we have a plan for not only the *Gathering Space* (hall), but also addressing the eventual mechanical work (HVAC) in the church, needs of our office, meeting room spaces, and most of all that ACCESSABILITY across the board is addressed. Let's make sure there are no barriers to the amazing life we have as a Parish! So, yes, OHOS is alive and well, and I look forward to sharing the *Gathering Space* details, and how we might integrate a Strategic Plan in the weeks, maybe months ahead, lots to do! Thanks for your support!

Ok, no more space here, so I'll just say, **stay tuned**.... So much to share, Lent is too short to write it all, maybe we should make lent a few weeks longer? Maybe not *Fr. Markus*
