The Seminary was inaugurated in 1893 as the Papal Seminary, which was shifted to Pune, India in 1954. Since then, the Papal Seminary became the National Seminary of Sri Lanka. At present, the seminary caters to all the dioceses of Sri Lanka and to 13 Religious Congregations. This current year we have a grand total of 206 students (123 Diocesan Students and 83 Religious Students). We are also blessed with students from India and Senegal."
