Supporting Young Families at St Clement Parish

With a new school year upon us, St Clement Parish wants to support young families by equipping them with the resources to help remain engaged and participate in our local community of Faith. Here are a couple new initiatives you can expect.

Pew Inserts

To support a culture that welcomes young families, you will notice an insert in each pew with a message to parishioners, visitors and parents encouraging them to bring their children to Mass and offering tips on how they can have the best experience.

Busy Binders

Geared towards children 3-6 years old, binders with different catechesis themes, books, materials and sensory activities are available that children can use during the Mass in their pew. These busy binders encourage children to learn and explore the faith in a developmentally appropriate way. There will be a bin of busy binders available at the back of the Church as families enter for Mass where they can grab one and return on their way out.

The Kids Bulletin

Developed by a Catholic Canadian mom, the Kids Bulletin is geared towards kids 7 and up and offers comics and activities that tie in the Sunday readings and upcoming liturgical feasts. This will be made available every weekend and will be placed alongside the regular bulletin for families to take on their way out.

Children's Liturgy of the Word

We will still offer a Children's Liturgy of the Word. However, for this year, it will be held on the off months that there is no Youth Choir or First Communions. Children's Liturgy will use the methodology from the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is a ministry for children that is based on Scripture and the Sacred Liturgy. It is inspired by the principles of Montessori education and ensures an interactive and fruitful experience of God's Word.

Children's Liturgy will be offered at the 11am Mass for children 4-6 years old on the following dates:

October 22, November 19, January 21, February 18, May 19.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It has been a beautiful summer and it feels like forever since I've been able to write, 'From the Pastor's Desk'. I hope and pray you are all well.

In the midst of the summer a good bit of time has been dedicated to discerning, dreaming, and planning for this coming year. I want to thank those of you who have shared with me your hopes and dreams for St. Clement, over the past year, and those who have especially helped with planning out this next year. There are many 'irons in the fire' as they say, and certainly not too many 'cooks in the kitchen'!

So, this coming year we have a number of wonderful things planned, to be honest, it almost seems like too much to communicate. So let me put into point form a few of the areas we are working on:

One thing I wanted to focus on for this weekend was to note the announcements in the bulletin regarding our choirs/music ministry. I'm excited along with Marilynn and Michael to support the incredible gift of music we have here at SC. I also again want to thank Sharon, Angie and all those who have been involved in the Praise Choir over the years!

From the announcements in the bulletin this weekend you will see a few of the plans and details for the year ahead for our music ministry. First is to note the investment we want to make in building up the membership of our choirs. Our Celebration Choir (11am), the Resurrection Choir (funerals), and our continuing and growing Schola Cantorum (Chant Choir), are all actively looking for new members. A big part of this year will be focusing on building up these choirs and our amazing cantors who make our liturgies so beautiful. Please consider joining!

We have also tried to think a great deal about what makes each Mass unique, how we can make SC not only thrive within, but offer compelling experiences for those who might join us. Knowing not everyone enjoys the same experience at Sunday Mass, or that some variety is appreciated (like with our 5pm Praise Choir over the past years), we have decided to step into the character each Mass seems to have, with a little more intentionality.

So...you will see first that the 9am will be led this year by our Schola Cantorum, our Chant Choir. Many who come early Sunday morning have shared with me their love of this type of music and their hope to hear more of our great schola. While a bit different from the usual, I trust with time it will draw not only existing parishioners to a love of this treasure of the church but will also attract new members to our community.

We also want to allow the amazing beauty of the Celebration Choir (11am) to flourish this year. New members, new music books, new and exciting ideas as they unfold will help this choir to continue to do well.

Finally, with the retirement of our Saturday 5pm Praise Choir, we have decided for the time being to keep Saturday as our 'low Mass', as it has been through the summer. While not having music at a Lord's Day Mass is not the norm we are used to, it does I know help some to feel like they are able to participate more fully. Some enjoy the greater silence, some have shared that being more elderly, singing has become more difficult, and perhaps for others, just knowing Mass is that 10 to 15 minutes shorter, will help them to be able to come, and stay!

So, each Mass here at SC has a bit of a character...just like us, the many members of the church. Perhaps this is a good time to see what the right fit for you is, perhaps a good time to invite someone new to join us and experience these opportunities with us!

Thanks for your prayers, support, and encouragement. I am looking forward to sharing more with you as the weeks and months unfold.
