We will use this response at all our Masses, weekday and Sunday through the whole year.

These new baskets are more 'self-serve', meaning that we will now pass the basket one to another from the front to the back. A little different but also a great way to connect and tangibly feel the gift we give, hand on and offer as one people of faith.
