Society of St. Vincent de Paul – YEAR END Report to the Parishioners of St. Clement's Church

In 2023, the 20 members of the St. Clement's Church **Society of St. Vincent de Paul** provided grocery vouchers and other

assistance totaling more than \$62,900 to the needy in Cambridge within the boundaries of St. Clement's Church. Funds donated to our Society were used to support 637 needy families (including 1,101 adults and their 680 children) during 2023.

This past Christmas, 15 St. Vincent de Paul members delivered Christmas greetings containing gift cards and grocery vouchers worth about \$15,400 to 82 needy families (including 163 adults and their 108 children). Our main source of funds comes from the generosity of the parishioners of St. Clement's Church. We thank you very, very much for your continued support of our Society as we strive to fulfill our mandate – the Christian calling to seek and find the suffering, the forgotten, and the deprived, and to bring them God's love through the gift of food and compassion.
