The past four years have presented many challenges to our parish league. From restrictions regarding public gatherings, in the early months of the pandemic, to limitations on how we can raise funds to support league operations and charitable giving, St. Clement's

CWL now finds itself having to find new ways to raise the funds required to allow our organization to continue in our parish.

After many conversations within our league and with other leagues in our diocese, a motion has been passed to introduce an annual collection of \$5/member to support the incidental expenses our league must meet each year. This collection will allow our league to forego ongoing fundraising and engage more fully in the parish and community initiatives we undertake. The exception to this will be our annual Christmas Bake and Craft Sale. This event has been a signature fundraiser for the CWL, for many years, and helps fund the monetary donations our league makes each year.

We hope each member of our league will understand and support this decision. CWL members may forward their \$5 contribution, for 2024, via the collection basket at weekend Mass, in an envelope marked "CWL" Moving forward, this amount will be collected with annual membership fees.
