### SSVP Community Impact Update – June, July, and August 2024

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul is extremely grateful for the support – both monetary & prayers – from the parishioners of St. Clement's Church in our *Mission of Charity*. With your kind generosity, the 20 members of the St. Vincent de Paul Society of St. Clement's Church were able to help a total of **166** families (including 297 adults and their 151 children) in the Preston area of Cambridge during the months of June, July, and August. In summary, during these three months, our Society:

→ Responded to requests for emergency food help and delivered **159** grocery vouchers to the homes of our Neighbours in Need in Preston.

→ Assisted **7** families in Preston with gently used clothing, furniture, and household goods from our St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store in Galt.
